

REQUIRED LICENSES & PERMITS

1. CT Firearms Hunting License
2. Private Lane Shotgun/Rifle Hunting Permit
3. Private Land Muzzleloader Permit
4. Small Game & Deer Hunting Archery Permit
5. Hunter must have a completed “Hunting on Private Land Consent Form” (which is found in the back of the Hunting Regulations) signed by the land owner (and must be on the hunter’s person).

LAND REQUIREMENTS

1. Require that all hunting must be from an elevated stand
2. Walk the property with the hunter so that he/she has knowledge of property and boundaries
3. Notification of contiguous property owners
4. Removal of all offal if required by land owner
5. Do Not pursue a wounded deer beyond the permit hunting boundaries, unless one has permission from the contiguous land owner
– Do Not Trespass

SAFETY

1. Hunter must wear 400 square inches of fluorescent orange clothing above the waist and visible from all sides
2. Archery hunters are exempt from wearing fluorescent orange except during the shotgun/rifle muzzle loader season when all deer hunters are required to wear 400 square inches of fluorescent orange
3. Hunter should always be shooting downward at their target
4. Check references
