I. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Ms. Algon.

ASPETUCK LAND TRUST REQUEST LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR GRANT

Mr. Woodman and Ms. Merrill explained they are filing a grant request for the Aspetuck Land Trust. They are asking for the Commission's written support for this grant to purchase a property that would increase the Wilton/Weston Forest Block, a rare pristine forest with connectivity to other Open Spaces.

Mr. Lapnow MOVED to SUPPORT the Aspetuck Land Trust Grant Application, SECONDED by Ms. Healy, and CARRIED 6-0-0 with all in favor.

PLANNING AND ZONING REFERRALS

A. SP#480, 863-875 Danbury Road, Connecticut Humane Society, to allow the construction of a new 14,243 square foot building by way of Section 29-5.A.3.r., for charitable organizations of residentially-zoned properties when fronting on Danbury Road.

Commissioners discussed the Application for both Planning & Zoning and Inland Wetlands referrals. The only comment relates to the Applicant including a maintenance schedule on the pervious pavement and stormwater management systems.
