Notice of Upcoming Sanitary Sewer Testing

When: Weeks of October 30, 2023; November 6, 2023; and November 13, 2023
(weather permitting)

Wright-Pierce, on behalf of the Town of Wilton, will be conducting testing of portions of the Town sanitary sewer system within the Town or State right-of-way.

This test will assist our inspection crews in locating breaks and defects in the sewer system. The work includes blowing non-toxic fog (similar to a fog machine) into the sewer through manholes along the street. You may see fog coming from the vent stacks and downspouts on houses, from holes in the ground, or from catch basins and drains. The fog is non-toxic, non-staining, has no odor, is white to gray in color and creates no fire hazard.

If fog enters your home or business during the testing, this is a good indicator that sewer gases may also be entering your home or business. Please notify work crews on site or Kristin Sullivan at the phone number below.

All field personnel will carry a photo identification badge displaying the Wright-Pierce logo.
