I will not be able to attend the next EDC meeting as I will be out of town. I wanted to provide an update on my progress on various projects:

- I am developing the content for **Opening a Business in Wilton, CT** guide and have met with Bob Nerney to discuss/review. I will present a draft to you all at your December meeting.
- I have sent **40 Things We Love About Wilton, commercial video and residential video** to Wilton based real estate brokers. I will also send to Fairfield County based real estate brokers.
- CTvisit.com. I have been working with the CT Office of Tourism to update Wilton attractions
 featured on their website. They have added Ambler Farm, Wilton Open Space Lands/Trails, and
 they are working on adding the NRVT. Janet Crystal at the Wilton Library Association will be
