"Kevin Gardiner and Debra Thompson-Van of Wilton Go Green met with the WestCOG fellows last Thursday (6/13). We only received 40 of the first 100 points that we submitted, but we have clear direction on what we need to do to get the remaining 60 points when we resubmit on or before the August 30 deadline.

Upon review with the WestCOG Fellows, we realize that the submissions require more detail then we anticipated. The Fellows recommended that we submit 250 points to ensure we hit the 200 point requirement.
