- 1. Chairman Hampson called the meeting to order at 7:11 PM.
- 2. Peter Wrampe Moved and Gil Bray seconded a motion approve the Minutes of the January 22, 2014 Meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3. WGG Report: Karen Stanley, .
