- 1. Chairman Hampson called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.
- 2. Approval of Minutes of August 28, 2013 Meeting: Peter Wrampe moved and Rob Sanders seconded a motion to approve the Minutes and it was passed unanimously.
- 3. PACE: Mark Robbins reported on the status of his work with Debra Thompson -Van to introduce the PACE program to appropriate Commercial Owners. Hal Clark reported on the dinner with Lee Wilson, Jessica Bailey ,Debra Thompson Van and Bruce Hampson . Mr. Wilson agreed to help the Commission publicize the program.
