Minutes of Special Fire Commission Meeting

March 8, 2017

Present: Commissioners J. Casey Healy, Ross Tartell and Christopher Weldon

A. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 1612 hours at the offices of Gregory and Adams – 190 Old Ridgefield Road, Wilton, CT.

B. Executive Sessions:

- a. At approximately 1613 hours upon motion duly made and seconded, the Commission went into Executive Session to interview Apparatus Supervisor candidate Ricky Petrizzi and invited Mr. Petrizzi, Chief Kanterman, Deputy Chief Amatrudo, Director Taffel and Apparatus Supervisor Nathanson to join the Session. At approximately 1652 hours, the Commission returned to regular session with no action taken.
- b. At approximately 1653 hours upon motion duly made and seconded, the Commission went into Executive Session to interview Apparatus Supervisor candidate Joe Cavo and invited Mr. Cavo, Chief Kanterman, Deputy Chief Amatrudo, Director Taffel and Apparatus Supervisor Nathanson to join the Session. At approximately 1728 hours, Mr. Cavo left the Session. At approximately 1751 hours, the Commission returned to regular session with no action taken.

C. Vote on Apparatus Supervisor candidate: Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to extend a conditional offer of employment as Apparatus Supervisor to Ricky Petrizzi.

Executive Session - Update on status of CBA arbitration:** Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Commission went into Executive Session to receive an update from Director Taffel regarding the status of the arbitration of the collective bargaining agreement between Firefighter Local 2233 and the Town and invited Director Taffel to join the Session. At approximately 1753 hours, the Commission returned to regular session with no action taken
