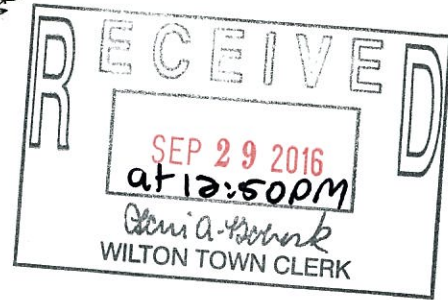

Meeting Minutes**

- I. Call to order
 - a. Attendance

Commissioners Fawcett, Sanders, Whitten, Follett and Lenihan was seated.

- b. Approval of June minutes

Sanders moved to approve, Lenihan seconded, all approved

- II. Ongoing Business
 - a. COA for 3 Church Street

Owner did not attend. Owner provided design sketch and image of pillar. Commissioners pleased to hear that P&Z verbally requested that porch be as close to historic-original as possible. Commissioners will not issue COA, requested more design detail

- b. Wilton Congregational - parsonage renovation

Commissioner Follett updated on renovation of 77 Ridgefield Road home. Most work is interior, windows will have narrower mullions requested by Commission.

- c. "1726 First Meeting House" marker moved from Lambert Corner to Wolfpit Rd

Commissioner Follett reported that c1935 stone marker, originally placed on Wolfpit Rd but moved in the 1970's due to Rt 7 expansion plans, has been returned to near original location. It has been placed road-side in the stone wall near Range Rd (Peter Hastings property). Bob Russell, Chris Lavin also

involved with planning, Dave Smith moved the stone. Commissioner Sanders requested complete information to include in Historical Soc newsletter.

- d. Wilton Historical Society – status of grant to update/improve 1989 historic structures survey

Commissioner Sanders reported that there is little to report. The grant proposal was submitted and, unusually, there has been no response. Commissioner Fawcett circulated her updated list of properties/structures.

There have been discussions with homeowners in the north Wilton, Bald Hill Cemetery area. There is some interest. Commissioners Fawcett/Sanders to follow up, suggested a mailing to homeowners to explain historic district process and value. Other potential districts: Cannondale, Ambler Farm.
