Special Meeting MINUTES

April 6, 2018

Comstock Community Center Room 14 2:00 pm

- I. Call to order - Meeting was called to order at 2:00 pm
 - a. Attendance – Sanders, Weatherly, Follett and alternate Gaboriault was seated
 - b. Minutes – Minutes from meetings on February 6 and 26, April 3 were distributed. Sanders called for a motion to approve, made by Weatherly, second by Follett, no discussion, all voted in favor of approving minutes.
- II. Demolition Request: 270 Sturges Ridge Road – Review of property by commissioners, discussion that property was not of historic value. Weatherly made a motion not to delay demolition, second by Follett, no further discussion, all voted in favor.
- III. COA: Wilton Historical Society – Tenant Signage at Lambert Corner – Sanders presented proposal for new, coordinated and appropriate building identification signs at Wilton Historical Society properties, and stated she would recuse from voting as she works at the Society. Society goal was to install signs on each building using unifying design with restricted colors, layout, text, which continues previously approved signage program. Purpose is to benefit businesses, assist deliveries and improve identification for emergency vehicles. Will also provide the historic name and building date of the structure, and the date it was re-located to the site for preservation. This systematic approach would also negate some tenants desire to use inappropriate temporary signs to attract customers. After some discussion, Weatherly moved to approve, Follett second, no further discussion, all voted in favor.
- IV. Adjournment – Meeting was adjourned at 2:20 pm
