As you know, our firm represents FDSPIN 141 DR LLC (the "Applicant") in the above-referenced application (the "Application"). I understand that the third-party engineering review will not be completed by the next Inland Wetlands Commission (the "Commission") meeting on August 12, 2021. Therefore, the Applicant would like to use the allotted time on the 12<sup>th</sup> to address comments made in your staff report and provide the additional details on the site development plan you requested.

Due to the timing of the third-party review, I understand the public hearing on the 12<sup>th</sup> will be continued again to September 9, 2021, at which point, we will hear from the third-party reviewer and respond to any questions/comments raised. As you know, a public hearing before the Commission must be completed within thirty-five days of commencement.<sup>1</sup> Thus, the Applicant is writing to provide written consent to a 15-day extension to September 9, 2021 to complete the public hearing regarding the Application.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Pursuant to Section 11.2 of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourse Regulations for the Town of Wilton, and Section 8-7d of the Connecticut General Statutes, public hearings held by the Commission must be completed within 35 days, unless the applicant grants the Commission additional time to complete the public hearing.

Only 14-days of extension are required to permit the public hearing to continue on September 9, 2021. However, the Applicant grants a 15-day extension in the event the hearing continues into the morning of September 10, 2021.
