Fallen and dangerous trees in restricted area

Dear Mike, I am following up on my call to you, where I mentioned that we have three fallen trees that have wedged onto other standing trees creating a very dangerous situation and we also have one tree that has a significant lean (Exhibit 1& 2). In addition, we have two trees that have fallen to the ground (Exhibit 3). The leaning trees represent a safety hazard and the fallen trees retract from the landscape.

The town (Mike Conklin) committed to have the Wetlands Commission team review the situation and to provide counsel on these trees, which I would appreciate you confirming has taken place and when we can expect feedback.

These trees need to be removed from our property and I request that Wilton provide approval to do so and also adequately record that the trees have fallen naturally for future reference.
