Subject: Cease and Desist order or 141 Danbury Road, Wilton CT

Dear Mr. Conklin:

As you may recall from my email of June 15th, we are representing the owners of 141 Danbury Road the Fab Five, LLC in order to resolve the Cease and Desist issued for the activity on the property. From reviewing the description of the unauthorized activity discovered in March 2020 in your cease and desist order; existing trees were removed and wood chips deposited on the disturbed areas along the banks of the Norwalk River.

I visited the site on June 15th to observe the area where the trees were removed and the wood chips deposited and assessed how we might restore the area. I also asked Chris Allan our soil scientist to look at the site for wetlands. Chris identified the main areas as "historical" fill and a very small area of alluvial soils in the northerly corner of the site. The alluvial soil has not been disturbed and we are not proposing any activity in or near it.

Since then we have prepared a restoration plans that I have attached here that includes a number of trees, lower shrubs, some ground cover and a seed mixture for the conditions along the banks of the Norwalk River.

I will be in attendance at the June 25, 2020 Inland Wetlands Commission hearing to address the cease and desist order and present our plans.
