

Violation: Conducting site work beyond the approved site plan and for failing to meet Permit Special Conditions prior to commencing activities at 20 Cheese Spring Road (Assessor's Map#103, Lot#43-1), Wilton, CT 06897

Wetland Regulation Violated: Section 14.3

REASON: You are hereby cited for violation of the Inland Wetland and Watercourse Regulations of the Town of Wilton for conducting site work beyond the approved site plan and for failing to meet Permit Special Conditions prior to commencing activities. As indicated in the Wilton Ordinance Establishing Citation Procedures and Fines for Violations of the Inland Wetland and Watercourse Regulations ("the Ordinance"), and pursuant to Section 22a-42g of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and in addition to the remedies provided in Section 22a-44 thereof, your violation has caused a fine to be levied against you.

You have thirty (30) days to make full payment by mail to the Town of Wilton, Inland Wetland Office, Town Hall Annex, 238 Danbury Road, Wilton, CT 06897. You can also deliver the payment in person using the drop box in the Town Hall Annex vestibule. Checks are to be made payable to the "Town of Wilton." Please note the Citation number on your check.

You have the right to contest your liability before the Citation Hearing Officer as provided by Section 4 of the Ordinance. Should you fail to pay the fine required by this citation within thirty (30) days, and should you choose not to request a hearing, the Hearing Officer shall thereupon enter judgment and assess the fine(s) as stated by citation(s). Failure to pay the assessment of any fine(s) made by the Citation Hearing Officer or failure to appeal his/her decision to the Superior Court within thirty (30) days of notice of his/her decision can result in a Superior Court judgment as provided by Connecticut General Statutes Section 7-152c.
