The only thing that has changed is that Mr. Montanaro has decided that it will cost him less money to place the utility lines overhead. As you well know, the driveway Mr. Montanaro is constructing bisects the Aspetuck Land Trust's Honey Hill Preserve. This highly destructive and intrusive driveway will only become more destructive and intrusive if he is allowed to string overhead wires along its shoulders. I hope the Commission will agree and deny Mr. Montanaro's request to modify the existing permit.
