Upon review by the Commission at a duly noticed public meeting, the following decision was made:

RESOLVED:

that Wetlands Application #2830 to conduct "Intermediate Regulated Activities," as defined by Section 2.1.z of the Wilton Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations be granted to Joe and Kelly Lash for property located at 28 Olmstead Hill Road, Wilton, CT (Assessor's Map#91, Lot#15). The authorized activity consists of a proposed in-ground spa 29 ft. from a wetland as described in the following documents:

- 1. Application for an Intermediate Regulated Activity, with supporting documentation, dated August 26, 2022, signed by the Agent
- 2. Project Narrative, undated, prepared by Meegan and Ramos Pools
- 3. Wetland Delineation Report, dated August 21, 2020, prepared by Pfizer-Jahnig, signed by Mary Jaehnig
- 4. Wetland Flagged Map, dated August 14, 2022, prepared by Mary Jaehnig
- 5. Watershed Map, undated, unknown preparer
- 6. Zoning Location Survey, dated July 26, 2022, prepared by Ryan & Faulds, signed and sealed by Lawrence Posson, LS, CT Lic#18130
- 7. Email correspondence between Agent and Staff, dated August 31, 2022
- 8. Email from Staff to Commissioners, dated August 31, 2022
- 9. Email correspondence between Agent and Staff, dated September 1, 2022
- 10. Location Map, undated, prepared by Wilton GIS
- 11. Email from Staff to Agent and Owner, dated September 15, 2022

This permit is subject to the attached General Conditions and the following special Conditions:

- 1. Prior to the commencement of any on-site permit related activity, the applicant shall submit an estimate for the cost of the erosion and sedimentation control plan for approval by this commission or its staff for the purpose of determining a bond amount.
- 2. Prior to the commencement of any on-site permit related activity, the applicant shall post a bond in a form and an amount acceptable to this commission and town counsel. The portion of the bond attributed to the planting plan shall be eligible for release at the end of the second full growing season after the planting plan is fully implemented. No portion of the bond is eligible for release until Special Condition #4 below is satisfied. In the event

the applicant fails to properly implement and maintain the planting plan and the erosion and sedimentation control plan, the Town reserves the right to use the bonded funds to correct such deficiencies.

3. The applicant shall cause to be prepared a final as-built plan that depicts the wetlands, watercourses and their regulated areas. The plan shall also include a note directing the reader to the office of the Inland Wetlands Commission for further information regarding WET#2830. This plan shall be in a form suitable for filing on the Wilton Land Records. The applicant shall file copy of the plan on the Wilton Land Records. The applicant shall submit two copies of the filed document to the office of the Commission. No portion of the bond in Special Condition #2 above may be released until this condition is fully satisfied.

GENERAL CONDITIONS IN THE ISSUANCE OF ALL WILTON INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION PERMITS

- 1. The permittee shall notify the Director of Environmental Affairs 24 hours prior to the commencement of work and upon its completion.
- 2. If the authorized activity is not completed on or before <u>9/22/27</u> said activity shall cease and, if not previously revoked or specifically extended, this permit shall be null and void.
- 3. No equipment or material including fill, construction materials, or debris, shall be deposited, placed, or stored in any wetland or watercourse on or off site unless specifically authorized by this permit.
- 4. All work and all regulated activities conducted pursuant to this authorization shall be consistent with the terms and conditions of this permit. Any structures, excavation, fill, obstructions, encroachments or regulated activities not specifically identified and authorized herein shall constitute a violation of this permit and result in its modification, suspension, or revocation. Upon initiation of the activities authorized herein, the permittee thereby accepts and agrees to comply with the terms and conditions of this permit.
- 5. Prior to commencement of any construction, including road, accessways, drainage systems, and lots, each and every general contractor and subcontractor employed by the applicant or subsequent purchaser shall execute a document in the form annexed indicating that the contractor or subcontractor has fully familiarized itself with and understands the Wilton Inland Wetlands and Water Courses Regulations as they apply to its project, and with the terms of the permitted activity, including the general and special conditions which pertain.
- 6. The permittee shall employ best management practices, consistent with the terms and conditions of this permit, to control storm water discharges, to prevent erosion and sedimentation and to otherwise prevent pollution of wetlands or watercourses. For information and technical assistance, contact the Director of Environmental Affairs. The permittee shall immediately inform the Commission of any problems involving wetlands or watercourses which develop during the course of, or which are caused by, the authorized work.
- 7. In evaluating this application, the Commission has relied on information provided by the applicant and, if such information subsequently proves to be false, deceptive, incomplete and/or inaccurate, this permit shall be modified, suspended or revoked.
- 8. Nothing in this permit shall obviate the requirements for the applicant to obtain any other assents, permits or licenses required by law or regulation by the Town of Wilton, State of Connecticut and the Government of the United States, including any approval required by the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Obtaining such assents, permits or licenses is the sole responsibility of the applicant.
- 9. This permit is subject to and does not derogate any present or future property rights or other rights or powers of the Town of Wilton, conveys no property rights in real estate of material nor any exclusive privileges, and is further subject to any and all public and private rights and to any federal, state and local activity affected hereby.
- 10. This authorization is not transferable without the written consent of the Wilton Inland Wetlands Commission.
- 11. Where applicable, the oil tank shall be above ground or in the basement of the dwelling.
