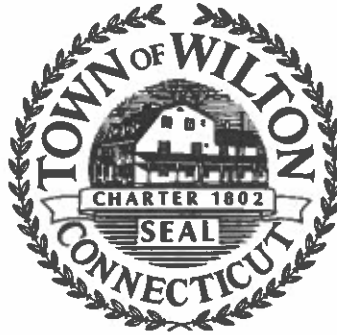

RE: C.G.S 8-24 Referral - Planning & Zoning
Seeley Road Bridge – Easements for LOTCIP Bridge Project No. L161-0002

This is written to obtain an CGS 8-24 Referral from Planning & Zoning for easements associated with the Seeley Road Bridge Preservation Project.

This project consists of the repair of Seeley Road Bridge. As part of the project, permanent and temporary easements are proposed on 3 properties adjacent to the project area (516 Danbury Rd, 8 Seeley Road, and the Wilton Land Conservation Trust property).

Preservation of the bridge is required based on its current traffic safety features, and that the existing superstructure is considered to be in a state of initial deterioration. Both bearings and girders are rusted with the underside of the bridge deck displaying spalls with exposed rebar. The approach rail system is also in bad condition and does not meet current design and crash testing standards. The project proposes to replace the existing bridge rail and curb system, install new approach guide rail, repair and paint steel beam ends, remove rust from bearings and paint, cover exposed reinforcement, mill existing overlay and apply membrane waterproofing, and to pave the bridge, while minimizing disturbance to traveling public. Construction of this project will be funded under the State's Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program. Design plans were prepared by WMC Consulting Engineers and will be in accordance with the Town of Wilton and Connecticut Department of Transportation design standards.

Attached for your review are the easement maps and page 1 of the project drawings depicting a general concept of the project.
