I am a lifelong resident of Wilton and I live just above the proposed property (81 Mountain Road) that is being considered for this project. It sounds all great on paper, except for the fact that this project will be build in a private residential neighborhood.

According to the draft site plans, there will be pathways and exterior animal runs and play areas and a rather large parking lot. This concerns us. What will be done to keep the sounds from traveling? What will be used to buffer the sounds of the animals and people and cars? This will be directly located in the back of our home...a parking lot, a gravel drive, outside runs and play areas. It is a shame that so much wildlife, wetlands are at risk to being lost, as well as how much the quality of our living in our residential home will affect us.

This proposed Humane Society is way, way too big for Wilton. Even at a smaller scale, if it were to be build just along Route 7 directly and not up on to the wetlands area and rocky terrain, we are concerned for our home and the quality of living and having this noise brought into our neighborhood.

Please let me know how we can get involved and be active in future hearings and meetings to represent our concerns and our opposition with this project.
