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MINUTES SPECIAL MEETING OCTOBER 30, 2019

CTO

Chairman Don Sauvigne called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were Commissioner David Waters, Commissioner Matt Mason, Chief John Lynch, Captain Robert Cipolla, and Captain Tom Conlan.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no members of the public present at the meeting, and no public comment was received.

MINUTES

Commissioner Sauvigne seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
