Investment Results

Chris Rowlins presented an overview of the Quarter and Calendar year 2016 results from his handout (on file)

In response to questions, Chris Rowlins presented his thoughts: 2017 returns and potential risks due to world events. Fiduciary Investment Advisors regularly runs scenarios based on changes in world events and tariffs and the impact of protectionism and currency wars.

A discussion was held about the achievability of the actuarial assumption of a 6 7/8% investment rate of return when 40% of the portfolio is in fixed investments
