Reasons for recommending this candidate:

The nominating committee of the Democratic Town Committee did not receive any responses to its solicitations for individuals interested in serving on the Board of Assessment Appeals (the "BAA"). It had met with Mr. Robert Wallace who was interested in another position but as to which another candidate possessed more impressive credentials. However, the committee saw Mr. Wallace as capable of serving the Town with competence and distinction on the BAA and asked whether he might be interested in serving on that board instead. After reflection and study, Mr. Wallace wrote back saying "Yes, I would be willing and able to serve on the BAA". Upon learning of this expression of interest, the members of both the nominating committee and the DTC itself gave their unanimous support to his application.
