Dear Chair of Water Pollution Control Authority Lynne Vanderslice and Members:

There is always an environmental risk associated with the construction of an underground pipe. Please err on the side of caution and oppose the sewer line extension – MR#154 proposal.

At the November 3rd Wilton Pollution Control Authority (WPCA) meeting concerns regarding the slope of the line were addressed, and at the January 12th meeting it was stated the Pump Station would not be in the ideal location.

My question is - What is the ideal slope for a sewage pipe, and please compare that to the slope of the pipe being designed for this project – and what that means?
