STATEMENT OF THE PROBLEM AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION PROBLEM IDENTIFICATION

To date, identifying the role distracted driving has played in fatality and serious injury crashes has been a challenge in Connecticut, due to the way crash data is collected and limitations of the crash reporting form (PR-1) itself. In order to effectively allocate 405(e) funds to multiple areas including enforcement mobilizations, the HSO chose to use an index of a combination of factors to best identify where the largest volumes of crashes, non-interstate roadway use, and population centers intersect. The goal of which is to target suspected locations where distraction as a result of hand held mobile phone use by drivers leads to crashes; and to identify areas where enforcement of Connecticut's hand held mobile phone for drivers can most be effective.

The applicant was selected by the HSO to conduct High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) based on a combination of the following data, weighted and ranked to determine areas where traffic volumes are highest, and the most crashes occur by town. The following ranking system was used by our data consultant.

- · Fatal and injury crashes 2015-2019
- Daily Vehicle Miles Traveled (DVMT) (2017)
- · Population (2017)
- Crash rate per DVMT
- · Crash Rate per population
- Past High Visibility Enforcement grant performance

The Wilton Police Department has identified as area of Town that has an increased amount of crashes compared to the rest of our Town. This identification was possible through the use of the UCONN crash data depository along with a review of our in-house records management system. In reviewing the data, we have determined that a majority of the crashes has a direct connection to distracted driving as many of the crashes involved citing the at fault vehicle for following too close. The charge of following too close is directly related to distracting driving in our experience. The Wilton Police Department has been conduction our own high visibility destracted driving enforcment in the areas identified, but based on call volume, we have been only able to conduct these details when we have extra manpower. This grant will directly affect our efforts to reduce the number of crashes in the identified areas. The are identified is along State Road 7 from State Road 33 to the intersection of State Road 7 and Olmstead Hill Rd. This are has a high volume of traffic during the commuting hours as well as throughout the day.
