RE: November 27th BOS Meeting Agenda

The following is information in advance of our meeting.

- School Buildings 10-Year Needs Assessment Report and Funding Possibilities. Look for an email on Friday mid-day with materials related to this item.
- Possible Extension of Contract for the Purchase of Electricity. You may recall we have a current contract for the purchase of electricity. Matt will present a request to extend the contract.
- Possible Appointment of Warren Serenbetz to the Council of Ethics. As promised, I spoke
  with Ira Bloom. He did not think there was legal risk should Warren Serenbetz be appointed
  to the Council of Ethics.

He noted a member of the Ethics Council must make decisions without bias. He suggested each BOS should make a determination as to whether they believe Warren can make decisions without bias. He suggested I ask Warren what, if any, his relationship is with Heather Priest. Do they have a personal friendship or a professional relationship? Did he have a role in her campaign, i.e. her campaign manager?

I called Warren. He indicated he didn't have a personal friendship or any relationship with Heather Priest. He stated he simply endorsed the BOE slate. Please let me know if you would like me to obtain written responses to my questions.
