Item E-4: Over the next three meetings, we will hear from Mike Conklin, Steve Pierce and Chris Burney about requests for funds from ARPA and Infrastructure funds. The related requests and their priority will have been approved by the Conservation and Parks and Recreation Commissions. Mike will present at Tuesday's meeting.

The current status of priorities for both funds, including the Conservation Commission's recommendations, is included on the enclosed spreadsheet, ARPA and Infrastructure Fund Priorities-2-18-22. As of 6/30/21 there was \$1.5 million in the Infrastructure Fund, of which \$134,000 has been spent or committed plus an unknown amount committed for the study of the two Georgetown town-owned houses.
