PLANT A TREE FOR OTHERS

Town of Wilton's Tree Donation Program Sponsored by the Wilton Tree Committee

Through the Town of Wilton's Tree Donation Program, Wilton residents have an opportunity to plant a tree in someone's memory or to celebrate the life of another by making a donation in that person's name. Such trees are a living tribute that benefits present and future generations. In addition to carrying forward the name of those honored, these trees can inspire energy, faith, devotion, and courage and will serve as an active participant in nature's plan for decades to come. To date, more than 70 trees planted through the Town of Wilton's Tree Donation Program enrich Wilton's landscape.

How the Tree Donation Program Works

All donated plants will be native species. Donors have a choice of planting a shade tree (such as a Northern Red Oak, Silver Maple, American Sweetgum, Northern Catalpa, Tulip Tree, or Weeping Willow, to name just a few) or understory tree (including the Flowering Dogwood, Redbud, American Hornbeam, Eastern Red Cedar, American Holly, or Witch Hazel, among others). Alternatively, donors may choose to plant a grouping of shrubs (such as Ninebark, Spicebush, Blueberry bushes, Summersweet, Serviceberry and many [different] kinds of native Viburnums).

The Wilton Tree Committee, a subcommittee of the Town's Conservation Commission, will determine the best species of trees or shrubs to plant and will select an appropriate location in town in accordance with the current Master Plan for Wilton. Numerous factors are taken into consideration when selecting the species (plant characteristics and requirements, size at maturity, and life expectancy) and eventual location (amount of space, aesthetics, foot traffic, public access, and safety).

Donated trees or shrubs are generally planted in the fall to help ensure their establishment with the least environmental or seasonal stresses. At the time of planting, An engraved brick will be placed at the base of the tree or group of shrubs indicating its taxonomy (both common and Latin names), the year of planting, and

the name of the person being honored. <mark>Registration to donate a tree or shrubs can</mark> be made at any time of year and the funds will be held in a marked account pending their planting.

Whether commemorating the loss of a loved one or celebrating the life of another, <mark>a</mark> vibrant, beautiful tree<mark>s and shrubs</mark> benefit<mark>s</mark> everyone in this life and for generations to come.
