 - ✓ Yearly maintenance projects & costs ongoing & project based
 - ✓ Annual capital projects inclusive of long-term replacement costs
 - ✓ Long range multi-year capital projects inclusive of long-term replacement costs
- We desire a Public/Private partnership to determine how projects are funded & envisioned to ensure utilization & quality
 - ✓ Town and Coalition co-funded
 - ✓ Coalition funds 100%
 - ✓ Coalition supplements town projects to get to desired project outcome e.g, last 10%
- Be aspirational minded, but pragmatic in decision making
 - ✓ Support bringing businesses to Wilton
 - ✓ Have a good, better & best lens on what defines success

- Amazing community infrastructure for all modern sports fields and facilities, fun and available open play spaces.
- Modernize and enhance our sports fields, facilities and open play spaces.
- Fields/Facilities are essential to the ability to offer, support and grow high-quality programs for recreational and competitive use, while also encouraging an active lifestyle of all our residents.
- These spaces build pride and enhance a sense of belonging to our community.
- They have the potential to generate positive economic activity to support local businesses and initiatives.
- Community sports fields and facilities, and open play areas are gathering places for families and friends all year long.
- Encouraging an active lifestyle of all our residents whether a solo, business, group or organized activity.

 - ✓ Business e.g., Recreation leagues
 - ✓ Group e.g., Cricket
 - ✓ Organized e.g., Club
- And finally, they make Wilton a more attractive place to be and live. Through the development of actionable ideas and long-range
 thinking we can solidify Wilton's future as a model community with first-class town amenities for the active youth and adults of our
 hometown.

Why Now? – Macro View

- ✓ Extended shut down of Stadium and Lilly Field in Fall '21 caused significant pain to entire community
- ✓ Wilton youth sports & community leaders are as connected and collaborative as we can ever recall
- ✓ Opportunities to bring economic activity to Town around Wilton-sponsored events / activities
- ✓ Participation and joining in multiple youth sports in Wilton is growing multiple sports, sports programs & seasons
- ✓ Desire to offer more programs in the community to support recreation and competitive participants
- ✓ Youth sports (volunteer organizations) seasons overlap, straining and limiting the available field space as is...
- ✓ Inclement weather (123 days/year) closes fields often, stunts seasons and impacts playability
- ✓ Existing surfaces raise many safety concerns, and are expensive to maintain at sub par status quo levels
- Community members want to donate to this type of cause but there is no entity to bring projects to life

Types of Projects We Are Thinking About For Conversation

Maintenance

- Specific improvements and additions to fields (backstops, fencing, equipment storage, etc)
- Cost to maintain and repair at desired levels

Annual Projects (temporary & long-term assets)

- Making non-utilized field spaces available, functional, additive
- Improved amenities near / around fields
- Community service days with local businesses
- Improved fields playing surfaces indoors / outdoors

Long Term Projects (temporary & long-term assets)

- Additional multi-sport turf field(s)
- Community centric facilities
- Adaptability of facilities for other opportunities
- Additive or upgraded field / play spaces at and around Wilton public schools
 - ✓ Small footprint areas to serve after school programs/youth sport collaborations, make multi functional
- Major school renovation projects (eg future Middlebrook renovation) with potential to effectively incorporate and redesign outdoor / athletic / play space in coordination
