## Town of Wilton July 4th Celebration Events Return

The Town of Wilton's Parks and Recreation Department is pleased to announce the return of its traditional July 4<sup>th</sup> celebration events. Both events, the Freedom Run 5K Road Race and the Fireworks Show, will be held on July 4<sup>th</sup> at the Wilton High School (WHS) Complex at 395 Danbury Road.

## 8:30 am - Freedom Run 5K Road Race, WHS Track

The Freedom Run begins at 8:30 am at the WHS Stadium track. Multiple categories are available to choose from, including junior and youth. Register online through <u>e-Trak.</u> Participant fees are \$20 for adults and \$10 for kids 14 and under. All participants receive a race t-shirt. Advance registration is encouraged. Same day registration is allowed. Participants should arrive by 8:15 a.m.

## 5:00 – 9:00 pm -- Live DJ and Fireworks Show at WHS Complex

Live DJ music begins at 5:00 pm followed by fireworks at sundown, approximately 9:00 pm. Bring a blanket, chairs and a picnic or visit the multiple food trucks. This event is free, though there is a fee for parking.

Advance-purchase only parking passes are available for the following premium parking lots:

- Route 7 Tennis Courts
- Cider Mill School
- Wilton Board of Education
- Wilton Athletic Fields lots along Lilly Way
- Route 7/School Road gravel lot.

Passes are \$35 per vehicle and can be purchased online through e-Trak or in-person at the Parks and Recreation office, 180 School Road, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday. Passes must be purchased by July 1st at 4:00 p.m. Passes must be picked up from the Parks and Recreation office between 8:30 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Monday through Friday by July 1st. If you prefer to have your pass mailed to you, you must purchase your pass online no later than June 20th, and call (203) 834-6234 to have it mailed. We do not guarantee delivery by the post office.

On July 4<sup>th</sup>, first come, first serve, parking for a cash-only fee of \$20 is available at the following parking lots: Middlebrook, Lilly Field, Stamford Health (372 Danbury Road) and Allen's Meadow.

In the event of inclement weather for these events, call the Parks and Recreation hotline at (203) 454-5188 for updates. The rain date for the fireworks display is July 5<sup>th</sup>.
