• 5:00 – 9:00 pm – Live DJ and Fireworks at WHS Complex

Bring a blanket, chairs and a picnic and enjoy music by Dance to the Music DJ. A traditional 4th of July style fireworks show will kick off at sundown estimated to be around 8:30 pm.

Parking passes for Route 7 Tennis Courts, Cider Mill School, Wilton Board of Education parking lot, and Lilly Way athletic fields. Passes can be purchased online for \$35 per vehicle on the <u>Parks and Recreation Online Registration System</u>.

Passes can also be purchased at the Wilton Parks and Recreation Department office, 180 School Road. Passes will be available through Friday, June 30th (passes will not be available for purchase on the day of the event). Vehicles without a valid parking pass will not be allowed to park in any of the aforementioned parking lots even if space permits. Ancillary parking outside of the pre-paid parking lots will only be available on a first come, first served basis.

Rain date for the fireworks is July 5th.
