**Application for Sewer Extension, Allocation of Sewer Capacity, and Approval to Connect a Multi-Family Development at 19 Cannon Road to Wilton's Sewer System**

Atty. Tom Hollister representing the applicant Baywing LLC gave a brief summary on the Application for the Sewer Extension for 19 Cannon Rd. Town attorney Pete Gelderman and DPW Director/Town Engineer further reviewed the application process to the board. Mr. Gelderman noted that the meeting this evening is preliminary for the board to put forth an 8-24 referral to the Planning & Zoning Commission before rendering a decision on the application. Discussion amongst the board with Mr. Gelderman, Mr. Hollister and Mr. Smeriglio. After discussion, motion to refer a possible sewer extension to 19 Cannon Rd to the Planning & Zoning Commission made by Mr. Nabulsi and seconded by Ms. Bufano. As there was no further discussion the motion carried 5-0.
