Call to Order

Eileen Armstrong called the meeting to order at 6:10 PM.

Ms. Armstrong asked for a motion to add an additional item to the Agenda – 158 Wolfpit Road before the FOG Program Update. Motion moved by Ms. Armstrong, seconded and unanimously carried.

Approval of Minutes

Approval of the minutes is postponed until the next meeting of the WPCA as some members present at the November 18, 2017 meeting were not present at this meeting.

Sewer Benefit Analysis - 21 Station Road

Mr. Ahern reviewed the Sewer Benefit Analysis for 21 Station Road. After review, item tabled until next meeting.

Sewer Benefit Analysis - 31 Old Danbury Road

Mr. Ahern reviewed the Sewer Benefit Analysis and the public sanitary sewer construction costs for 31 Old Danbury Road. Ms. Armstrong requested that the property owner provide backup to the General Contracting fees shown on the sewer cost summary. After review, item tabled until the next meeting.

Sewer Line Acceptance - Old Danbury Road

Mr. Ahern reviewed the Sewer Line Acceptance request for Old Danbury Road. After review, motion made by Ms. Martucci to schedule a Public Hearing for March 14, 2018 at 6:00PM to

accept Old Danbury Road sewer line into the Wilton Sanitary Sewer System. Motion seconded by Ms. Dhanda and unanimously carried.

158 Wolfpit Road

Ms. Armstrong noted that the Town received a request from a potential home owner to inquire if the WPCA board would have any issues with the potential home owner seeking relief from hooking up to the Wilton Sanitary Sewer System within 90 days after the purchase of the home. After review, the board had no objections, but if at any time that septic system fails, the property owner would be required to hook up.
