## Wolfpit Road Sewer Project Update

Mr. Ahern said that the sewer project is 95% complete with the sewer installation as of 4/1/13 and only three additional lateral connections had to be made. The contractor planned on connecting to the Miller-Driscoll School by the end of the week (April 19 – which has been done). Mr. Ahern handed out a progress map showing what was installed as of April 1<sup>st</sup>. (Attached herewith).

## FOG Program Update

In response to Mr. Brennan's request at the prior meeting, Mr. Ahern handed out a summary of penalties that are currently in the WPCA regulations - which was then discussed. Mr. Brennan asked the DPW to come up with recommendations on motivating the facilities that have not responded to their previous mailings to register/comply. The statistics are as follows: 91% registered and 71% compliant (a slight bump up on compliance from the previous report).

# 7. Other Business

Mr. Brennan gave the Members an update on the Sisters of Notre Dame sewer project. An 8-24 was submitted to P&Z after the Board of Selectmen's review and approval. Ken Bernhard is working on an agreement with the attorney for the Sisters of Notre Dame. The objective is to install this summer after school is out and have it fully completed prior to school opening in late August. McCord Engineering is doing the final drawings for presentation to the WPCA at their May 8<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Ms. Dennies reminded the Members that they need to approve the WPCA FY 14 Budget, establish the user charges for FY 14 and set a date for the Public Hearing.
