440 Danbury Rd Request for Sewer Main Extension & Connection to Sewers

Mr. Smeriglio reviewed the request from 440 Danbury Rd for sewer main extension and connection to the town sewers. Erik Lindquist of Tighe & Bond who represented the owners provided additional input. Mr. Smeriglio shared the applicant had previously received a denial from the Health Department for a septic expansion. Ongoing discussions with the Health Dept. After further discussion and review, motion to refer the extension of the sewer at 440 Danbury Rd to Planning & Zoning Commission subject to resolution of a question about the ability to have septic. Motion moved by Mr. Nabulsi, seconded by Mr. Cole and carried 5-0.

Calculation Method for Sewer Allocation

Mr. Smeriglio noted Craig Flannery of Redniss & Mead prepared and submitted an informational Water Use Study. In doing so, Mr. Flannery indicated he represented a number of potential applicants. Consensus of the Board of Selectmen to request consultants Wright Pierce review and comment.
