



Freshwater Farm, 14 Grumman Ave., Wilton. Home built, ca. 1790-1800. It was purchased in 1905 by Henry and Elizabeth Young, whose sons began a tree nursery business in 1930. This location was Young's Nursery until circa 1950 when the business moved to Danbury Road. Unusual trees were planted on this property and its former acreage and they continue to enhance the area. Of note, the Youngs supplied many specimen trees for nearby Cranbury Park.
